U.S. VFR PLANNING CHARTS Hudson River Class B Transition Route Chart and New York Special Flight Rules Chart

On **February 11, 2010**, the FAA will make available two new VFR Planning Charts to assist pilots in the navigation through and below the New York Class B airspace area. One chart will depict the new SKYLINE VFR transition route designed to assist navigation through the Class B airspace over the Hudson River. A second chart will depict the new Special Flight Rules Area designed to assist navigation below the Class B airspace over the Hudson and East Rivers.
